GET OUT AND PLAY.

Seriously. Does it get any better than this?

Blue skies. Stunning vistas. 18 holes of sheer joy (with maybe a bit of frustration). Southwest Idaho offers more than 20 of the most beautiful and diverse golf courses you can imagine.

Here you can tee off an elevated tee to the valley below or putt in the shadows of ponderosa pines. Occasionally even having to wait for the deer to clear the fairway.



GOLF IN THE HIGH

TREES: Try one of our mountain courses.

Popular destinations include McCall Golf Course and Whitetail Golf Club in McCall, Jug Mountain Ranch near McCall, and Terrace Lakes in Garden Valley.

GOLF IN THE HIGH DESERT: In and around Boise you'll find more than 15 area golf courses, including Shadow Valley, Falcon Crest, Banbury, and Ridgecrest.

WINE: The Snake River Valley appellation, one of the nation's newest wine regions, is right here. Tour wineries. Taste. Relax.

ENJOY A NIGHT (OR DAY) ON THE TOWN: Browse the Boise Art Museum, watch some live theater, or just take in dinner and a movie. You'll find it all in Boise.

Where To Stay

Stay where you play. If you want to golf in the trees, reserve a cabin right on one of the golf courses in McCall, New Meadows, Cascade, Crouch or Donnelly. If the courses in the Boise area interest you, choose any number of hotels, including many downtown or near the Spectrum entertainment district.



Also Consider

MOUNTAIN BIKE: Sure, Boise's been recognized by Bike Magazine as the nation's "#1 Mountain Biking Town," but mountain biking runs deep all through Southwest Idaho.

Bike the deserts and canyons of the Owyhee Canyonlands or the ridges of Idaho West Central Mountains. Your choice.



MOTORCYCLE, ATV: Southwest Idaho has thousands of miles of trails just waiting to be explored. Whether you like exploring deep into the forest or going wide open on a desert flat, you'll find it here.

A GOOD MEAL: Good restaurants are everywhere in Southwest Idaho, but look to downtown Boise for most of the area's fine dining, including restaurants specializing in steak and seafood, Northwest cuisine and more ethnic fare.
