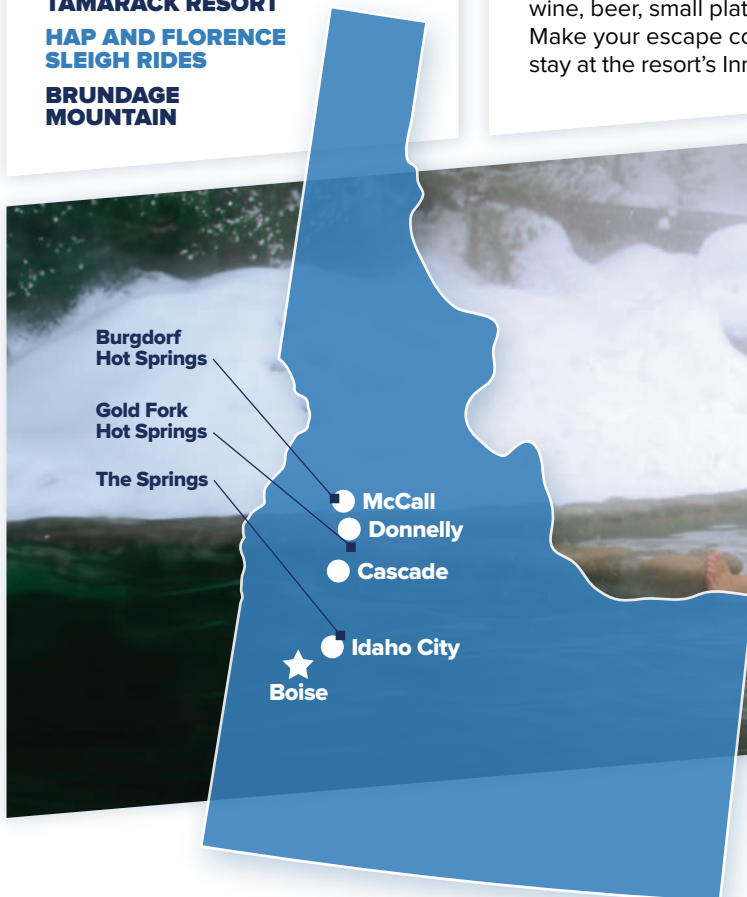
The resort's poolside service offers wine, beer, small plates and entrees. Make your escape complete with a stay at the resort's Inn the Pines.
